Lunch time clubs

At Galilee, we have various lunch time clubs run by either Galilee Staff or private contractors.

A reminder that the Microfibre Sport Jacket is **not** to be worn as a jumper over the Summer Uniform. It must be worn with the Sport Uniform. Likewise, the woollen jumper must not be worn with the Sport Uniform.

As an extra layer of warmth, the jacket may be worn over the woollen jumper when wearing the Summer Uniform.

The rugby jumper is also part of the Sport Uniform only. It must not replace the woollen jumper when the Summer Uniform is worn.


