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GALILEE REGIONAL CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL L.O.T.E. Policy

(Languages Other Than English)

Rationale

The LOTE Program (currently Italian) enables learners to increase their awareness of the multilingual and multicultural nature of Australian society, and prepare for a broader range of experiences in future use of the language in social activities including leisure, work and study.

Aims

- To develop an interest and enjoyment in a language other than English.
- To reinforce that listening, speaking, reading and writing are linked to, and dependent on, one another in the learning of another language.
- To develop communication skills and knowledge of the language.
- To foster an appreciation and respect for the views of other ways of life, languages and cultures.
- To understand social, historical, familial relationships and other aspects of the specific language and culture of the speakers of the language they are studying.
- To integrate LOTE with other curriculum areas where appropriate.

Program Description

- The LOTE program will be taught by the LOTE specialist, who will refer to the Victorian Curriculum as well as other resources to create a differentiated approach to the teaching and learning of Italian to all students in the school.
- LOTE lessons will be taught to students from Prep- Year Six. Students in Prep Year 2 will participate in 1x1 hour lessons per week. Students in Year 3-6 will participate in 1x 40min lessons per week.
- Lessons will reflect student needs and interests wherever possible and will provide opportunities to use the language in meaningful situations from everyday life.
- The program will be integrated with other curriculum areas where appropriate.
- An annual budget will be prepared in order to upgrade resources and reference material.
- Bi annually a day will be dedicated to the Italian Culture and Language will be organised by the Specialist Teacher in collaboration with classroom teachers.
